WHAT IS A FOOD DRIVE?

Since the Food Bank Singapore's establishment in 2012, we have been dedicated to bridging the gap between excess food and food insecurity experienced around the island.

Food Drives are a great way to generate additional donations for the Food Bank Singapore to ensure a steady supply of food rations. At the same time, they help raise awareness about food insecurity and food wastage and can inspire others to act as well!



WHAT KIND OF FOOD CAN BE DONATED?

- We accept all types of non-perishable food items that are unopened, unused, and with at least 5 weeks of shelf life.
- We do not accept: Rusty/Unlabelled cans, Expired items, Opened/Used items
- Currently, we are most in need of halal spreads, hot beverages (Milo & coffee etc.), instant noodles and halal biscuits & snacks!
- There is no minimum / maximum quantity of food items that can be donated. We welcome all efforts in ending food insecurity in Singapore!

After registering your interest with us, decide on a location to store your items throughout the Food Drive (e.g. reception/pantry/empty classroom)

Prepare your own carton boxes for storage and collection. You may choose to decorate it as you wish!

- Due to logistical and manpower constraints, unfortunately we do not provide any pick-ups. You may want to engage with external logistics for transport services.
- For any pick-ups **by The Food Bank Singapore** needed, a \$60 transport fee will be required. For schools, this transport fee is reduced to \$30.

- You may deliver to our warehouse address at 218 Pandan Loop, S128408 between Monday to Friday, from 10am-5pm.
- Do inform us of the delivery date and time in advance so that we can be on standby to receive the donations.


DIRECTIONS TO THE FOOD BANK SINGAPORE
